The IDEC@EUDEC starting on August 1st in Belgium presents a good opportunity to advance towards rights respecting education being adopted across the globe. A good number of people who participated in the RCE Making Change Stick sessions have indicated an interest in volunteer work aimed at engaging like-minded organizations and teachers in the collaborative task of bringing self-directed education to the mainstream. For their work to be fruitful, they need to be supported, and it falls to the IDEC community, and the people and organizations who have founded the Rights=Centric Education Network - RCEN, and/or have signed the Declaration of Child Rights-Centric Education to provide that support.

Numerous like-minded organizations and people have in the past been contacted and convinced to attend some related event, but they don't get engaged. There is poor attendance at the event and no buzz. They conclude nothing significant is happening and decide their time is better spent elsewhere, and it is harder to bring them back than it is to first bring them in. It is discouraging for the volunteers who encourage them to attend. They feel like they wasted the time of others, set the cause back a little and lost some personal credibility. We need to avoid this happening to those who volunteer to contact the like-minded.

IDEC Proposal - Make Something of the 2026 Learning Planet Festival

The 2026 Learning Planet Festival is where significant progress can be made towards engaging like-minded organizations. It is supported by UNESCO and has a long partners list of organizations we need to engage. We got a start at the 2025 Festival. Twenty-six events were conducted by supporters of the RCEN producing what can be described as a festival-within-a-festival and their contributions were appreciated by the organizers of the LP Festival.
